Nature and Structure (A3D)

Requirements:

- A) Consideration of Natural Forms
 - i. Patterns, Rhythms, Repetitions
 - ii. Organic structures & Scale
- B) Use of one or more Natural materials
 - i. Sticks, stones/pebbles, seeds, leaves, shells, dirt, etc.
- C) Use of one or more Human-made materials
 - i. Plastic, wire, hot glue, cardboard, lumber, newspaper, etc.
- D) May be representational (thematic) or non-objective

Objectives (100 points):

- 1) Something Turned In? (40 pts)
- 2) Thorough understanding of Material(s)/Methods? (0-25 pts)
- 3) Understanding of Visual Structure (pattern, rhythm, repetition)? (0-20 pts)
- 4) Unique Design and/or Compositional Aspects? (0-10 pts)
- 5) Integration/connection of materials, esp. natural materials? (0-5 pts)

Other Objectives:

- Daily Studio Performance? (0-15 pts)
- REFLECTION/Critique/Sketchbook notes? (0-15 pts)

Procedures:

- A) Collect materials, especially natural materials
- B) Experiment with connections/compositions (sketching in 3D)
- C) Complete final sculpture
