

2) <u>Hot Glue Gun</u>: The hot glue guns are on the worktables and used to glue cardboard – there is one hot glue gun per two students. The students are taught proper safety procedures. If a student does not treat the hot glue guns with the respect and responsibility, her/his privilege to use the hot glue guns is revoked.
